Scholarship Award Amount: \$250 (to be applied applied to the recipient's account for the following academic year.)

Even when he was over 90 years old, Mr. Don Rice still served the church faithfully as well as the school. He would stop by to check on the students and staff and he wanted to be sure that the building and property came to the school when the church closed.

In early December 2020, Mr. Don passed away due to Covid-19. Then, at the end of December, Ms. Bette passed away. The loss of two kind, generous, faithful servants in the community came as a blow. The best way to honor them was to establish the Don & Bette Rice Legacy Scholarship Program.

This Scholarship program is based on *servant leadership* and **not on a financial need.** Since, both Mr. Don and Ms. Bette served their church and community faithfully for 50 years, this scholarship will help their legacy live on. This scholarship is awarded to the student who best exemplifies the heart of a servant during the school year.

This Scholarship Program is underwritten by donations made in memory of Don & Bette Rice, and will be available as long as there are funds.
